Table Notes

Part of the process of curating and cleaning the NJFS data involved removing extraneous clips from the main video dataset because they contained little or no information about family dynamics or parent-child interactions. In particular, we removed clips that captured staff from Princeton University’s Office of Information Technology (OIT) during the initial in-home setup (SU) of the video recording equipment or teardown (TD) that occurred two weeks later. These clips were put into a separate folder labeled “Setup Videos.” Clips that are long enough to contain both family time and OIT setup or teardown time were left in the main folder.

The table shows how many OIT clips were removed from each household and each camera, separately for setup (SU) and teardown (TD) periods. NA means the corresponding camera number was not used in a particular household. A total of 1,585 clips was excluded from the main NJFS video folder, for an average of about 75 clips per household. The number excluded at the household level ranged from a minimum of 4 (ID# 1031) to a maximum of 211 (ID# 1015). The number of removals typically declined over time, presumably because OIT personnel became more proficient at installing equipment and because they were working in smaller homes with fewer rooms. Most of the clips moved to the Setup Video folder (96.6%) were recording during the setup period. Just 54 removals occurred during the camera teardown period. The number of setup clips removed from any given camera exceeded 60 in three instances. These clips usually had very short durations (5-10 seconds).
